If so, let me give you an idea. Think about having a “No Fault” class. In a “No Fault” class, every student is expected to reach 100% of the learning targets for the week. At the end of the week, you recognize and reward the whole class. This means everyone in your class will work together to accomplish the learning targets. Collaborative learning would be a strategy for ensuring 100%.

I suggest that you organize your instructional strategies with specific learning targets that the students can see, hear and understand. Let the students practice and apply what they have learned in a variety of ways, and use formative assessments to inform you and your students of how close they are to hitting the learning targets.
